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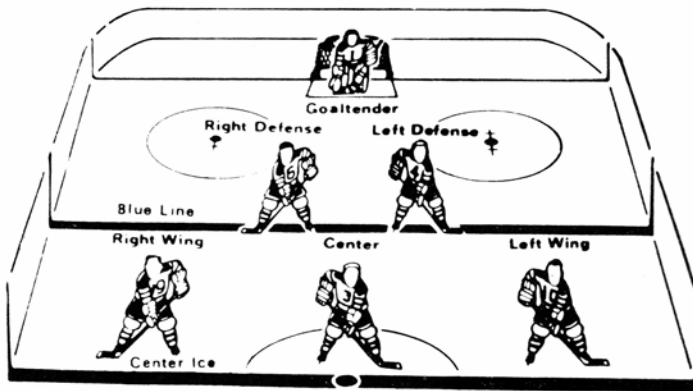

WHAT THEY DO

(1.) **Goalkeeper**

The Goalkeeper's main responsibility is to keep the puck from entering the goal and there are few restrictions placed on the methods he can employ. His offensive contributions are limited and consist of passing the puck up to teammates. He never scores goals and rarely assists.

(2.) **Two Defensemen**

Basically the two defensemen try to stop the incoming play at their own blueline. They also block shots, clear the puck, in front of their own goal, and watch forwards. Offensively they move the puck forward to the wings and center, into the attacking zone and try to keep it there.

(3.) **Center**

He is the 'quarterback' or the player who sets up plays, by passing to the wings. He is usually also a top goal scorer. Defensively he fore checks which means he harasses opposing defensemen into making mistakes.

(4.) **Two Wings**

They move up and down the sides of the rink, taking passes from the center and making plays. Defensively they fore check and back check. Wings account for the majority of scoring along with the center.

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OFFICIAL'S SIGNALS

DELAYED CALLING OF PENALTY

Referee repeatedly points with free hand (without whistle) to player to be penalized until play is stopped.



SLOW WHISTLE

Either arm in which whistle is held, extended above head. If play returns to Neutral Zone without stoppage, arm is drawn down the instant the puck crosses the line.



"WASH OUT"

Both arms swung laterally across the body with palms down.
1. When used by the Referee it means goal disallowed.
2. When used by linemen it means there is no icing or no offside.



CHARGING

Rotating clenched fists around one another in front of chest.



ICING

Arms folded across the chest.



INTERFERENCE

Crossed arms stationary in front of chest.



TRIPPING

Extending right leg forward clear of the ice, and striking it with right hand below the knee.



ELBOWING

Tapping either elbow with the opposite hand.



SLASHING

A series of chopping motions with the edge of one hand across the opposite forearm.



CROSS CHECKING

A series of forward and backward motions with both fists clenched extending from the chest.



HIGH STICKING

Holding both fists clenched one immediately above the other at the height of the forehead.



HOOKING

A series of tugging motions with both arms as if pulling something toward the stomach.



MISCONDUCT

Placing of both hands on hips several times and pointing to penalized player.



HOLDING

Clasping either wrist with the other hand well in front of the chest.

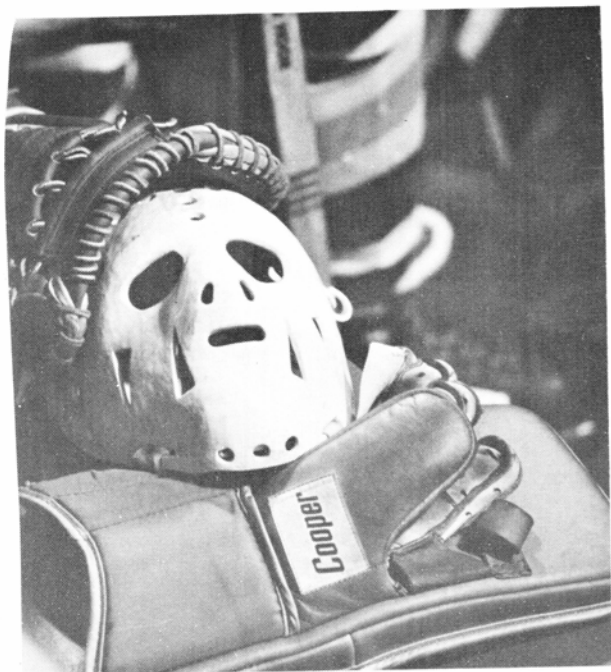

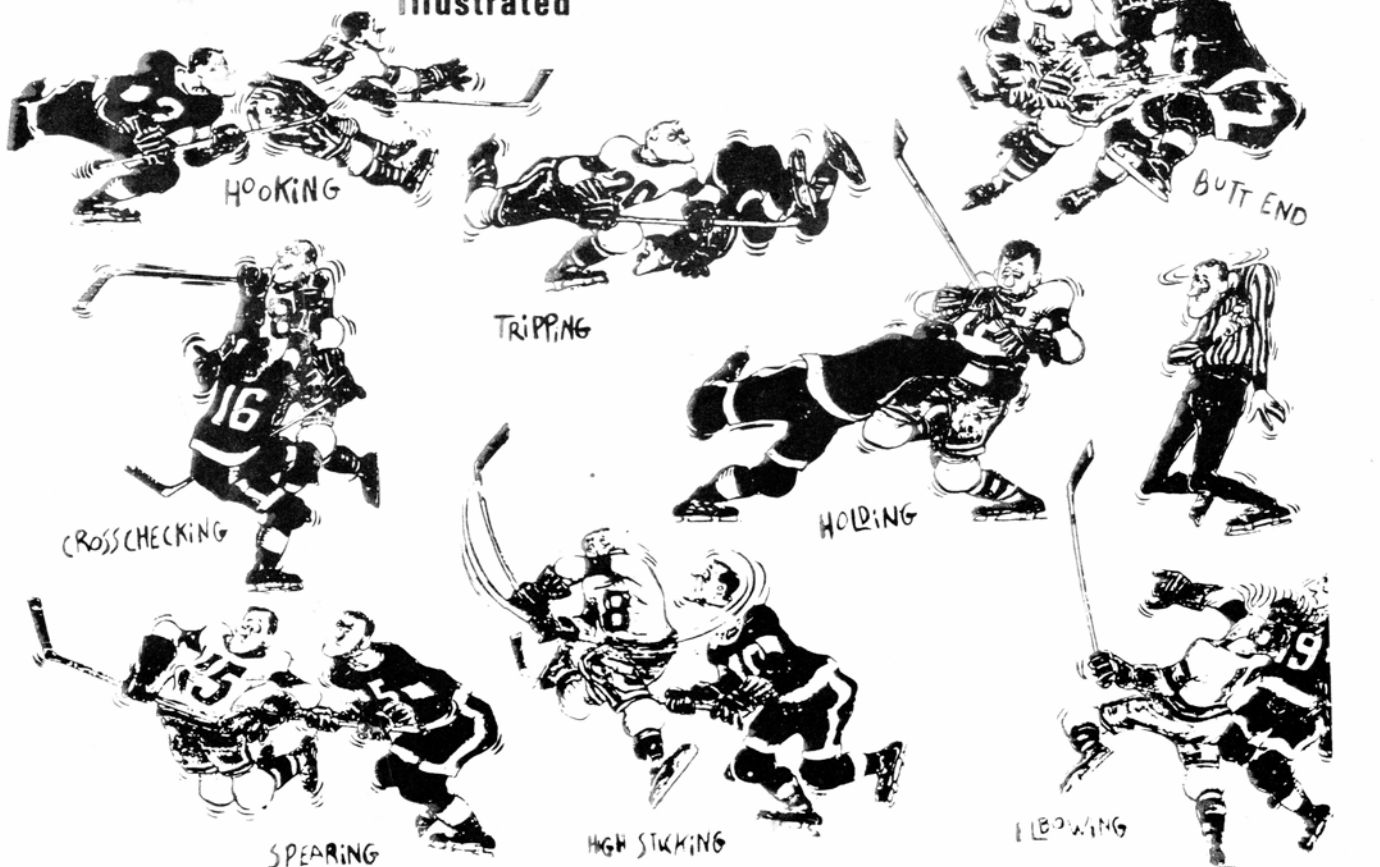

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HOCKEY DICTIONARY

ASSIST - A pass to a teammate which enables the latter to score a goal.

BACK CHECK - Covering. Same as guarding in basketball.

BANKING THE BOARDS - Player passing the puck to a teammate by rebounding it off the boards.

BOARDING - When players bang each other into the side boards.

BOARDS - Wall around the rink to keep game on the ring and out of fans' lap.

BODY CHECK - Same as block in football. Used to slow down opponents.

BREAKAWAY - When player breaks into clear and leaves his opponents far behind.

CAGE - The goal. (Also net)

CREASE - Four-by-eight foot areas marked in front of each goal. Goal is not allowed if offensive player is within the crease.

CROSS CHECK - Holding stick at arms length and jamming it into opponents anatomy.

FACE-OFF - Dropping the puck between players, much like jump ball in basketball.

FREEZING THE PUCK - When opposing players hold the puck against boards.

ICING THE PUCK - Shooting the puck the length of the rink when both teams have an even number of players on the ice.

KICK BOARDS - Small strip of wood at bottom of boards.

OFFSIDE - Offensive player in attacking zone ahead of puck.

PENALTY BOX - "Siberia" for penalized players.

POKE CHECK - Using stick at arms length in attempt to get puck from opponents stick.

PUCK - Flat-surfaced disc of hard rubber corresponding to ball used in other sports.

RAGGING PUCK - This is a defensive measure to waste time, and is used mostly when team is shorthanded through a penalty, or in the dying minute of the game.

REBOUND - A puck bouncing off goalie's pads.

SHINNY - Disorganized play.

SOLO PLAY - Goal scored on individual play, without benefit of assist.

SPLITTING THE DEFENSE - Carrying the puck between and completing the play beyond the opposing defense pair.

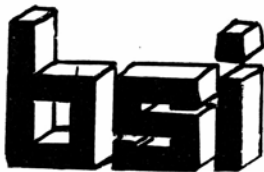
STICK - Not designed for committing mayhem, but for propelling puck along ice.

STICK HANDLING - Advancing the puck corresponding to dribbling as in basketball.

TRAILOR - Player who follows behind a teammate who is attacking with puck.
